

Highlights for Fiscal Year April 1, 2013 – March 31, 2014

Counseling Hours: Over 22,000 hours of counseling were provided in 20 locations. Of these hours, 2,000+ were provided through our Low Fee Clinic at fees under \$20 per session/hour. In total, we provided \$753,897 in uncompensated care.

Commitment to Diversity: Samaritan therapists have the ability to provide counseling in Spanish, German, Cantonese, Mandarin and several of the many languages spoken in the Philippines as well as in English. We welcome people of all faiths, backgrounds and lifestyles.

New Staff: Joining our staff of 30 state-licensed therapists was Matthew Percy, PsyD. Joining our Administrative Staff was Michele Fritz, Director of Marketing & Community Relations; James Marshall-Ward, Chief Administrative Officer and Stephanie Pietras, CareTeams Program Director.

New Board Member: Steve Gustaveson of St. Patricks Catholic Church in Seattle and William Starks of Bellevue Presbyterian Church.

New Program: The CareTeams Program came under our umbrella in January, 2014 after Rosehedge/Multifaith Works closed its doors.

Staff Development and Consultation: Psychiatric Consultant Dr. David Harrison, Assistant Professor in the Department of Psychiatry & Behavioral Sciences at the UW School of Medicine, meets monthly with our clinical staff. His interest and experience in the integration of spirituality and mental health make this particularly beneficial for our staff.

Other regularly scheduled Clinical Enhancement activities include monthly Continuing Education presentations and weekly Peer Consultation Groups.

Fund Development:

- Due to your generous donations, our **2013 Spring Luncheon and Auction** raised \$32,965 for the support of our low fee clinic.
- **United Way** renewed their support of \$47,500 for the CareTeams Program which supports those living with HIV/AIDES so they may remain in their homes.
- **Stewardship Foundation** awarded a grant of \$43,880 which enabled us to hire a Marketing & Community Relations Director.
- **Bellevue Presbyterian Legacy Foundation** contributed \$3,000 for the renovation of our 100-year-old building/chapel.
- University Presbyterian Church also awarded us \$6,000 which was utilized in conjunction with the
 monies received from Bellevue Presbyterian Legacy Foundation and Samaritan reserves to complete
 phase one of the renovation of the 100-year-old building/chapel. A staff member also generously paid
 for all the building/chapel lighting fixtures.

Sharing Our Space: We continue our intentional sharing of space with others who serve the community, including Children of the Nations and a number of 12-Step programs.

Ravenna Chapel Interior Renovation: The first phase of the project which included interior painting and flooring was completed in March, 2014.
